Our building is on the north side of Broadway, midway between Laurel St and Oak St. Suite 150 is on the Lobby Level.

Parking

Our building has an underground parade. The entrance is off the back alley, which is accessible form Laurel St. The cost is \$3.75 per hour or portion thereof, or \$11.00 per day. There is also paid parking on the surrounding streets.

Wheelchair Access

Elevators from the underground parade. There is also a wheelchair ramp at the main entrance to the building.

Transit information:

If using Expo Line or Millennium Line skytrain, the nearest stop is Commercial Broadway.

Transfer to 99 B-Line (UBC) bus (fastest) or No. 9 Bus westbound.

Disembark at the Willow Street/Vancouver General Hospital stop and walk west 1.5 blocks to our office.

If using Canada Line skytrain, the nearest stop is Broadway/City Hall.

Transfer to 99 B-Line (UBC) bus (fastest) or No. 9 or No. 17 Buses westbound. (Catch these buses at Cambie and Broadway in front of London Drugs).

Disembark at the Willow Street/Vancouver General Hospital stop and walk west 1.5 blocks to our office.

Buses along Broadway:

99 B-Line is an express bus running east and west, mostly between UBC and Commercial (every occasionally between UBC and Boundary during peak periods). If east bound, disembark at Willow Street/Vancouver General Hospital stop, cross the street and walk west for 2½ blocks to our office. If west bound, disembark at Willow Street/Vancouver General Hospital stop, and walk west for 1½ blocks to our office.

No. 9 bus runs east and west between UBC and Boundary. If east bound, disembark at Laurel Street stop, cross and street and walk west for ½ a block to our office. If west bound, disembark at Willow Street/Vancouver General Hospital stop, and walk west for 1½ blocks to our office.

No. 17 bus runs north and south between downtown and Marine Drive. If northbound, disembark at Laurel Street stop, cross and street and walk west for ½ a block to our office. If southbound, disembark at Willow Street/Vancouver General Hospital stop, and walk west for 1½ blocks to our office.

How do I prepare for the bone density test?

- If you have had a nuclear medicine test involving an injection or a GI/stomach/bowel x-ray involving a barium swallow, delay having the DXA test for 3 weeks.
- Please try and wear the following types of clothing:
 - Try to wear a top with no buttons, zippers or hooks, such as a T-shirt or sweater.
 - If you have a pair of slacks with an elastic waistband, that would be ideal. If not, then please wear loosefitting slacks.

- o If you are a woman, wear a sports bra with no wires or hooks. If you don't have one, that's OK; our technologist will know what to do.
- If you take calcium tablets, do not take your calcium tablet in the morning on the day of the test.
- If there is any chance you are pregnant, you should not have this test.
- If you are wheelchair-bound, you must be accompanied by someone who can help you transfer out of the chair and onto the testing table.
 - o The surface of the testing table is 2.5 feet off the floor.

What if I need to cancel my appointment?
